INVESTING in Place

In 2015 the City of LA finalized the **Willits Settlement**, a \$1.4 billion class action lawsuit to repair LA sidewalks for travelers with disabilities.

Willits requires a **sidewalk repair program** to spend at least \$25 million annually over the next 30 years.

> 11,000 miles of sidewalks in LA is the equivalent to traveling the coast of California 13 times

Almost half of the 11,000 miles of LA sidewalks need repair

Access Repair requests by and for people with disabilities



City Facilities Fix sidewalks next to City-owned property



Rebates Property owners pay to fix sidewalks and are eligible for a rebate
